DESERT PARTY raced up close along the backstretch, dropped back slightly while well in hand on the turn, moved through along the rail to take charge in upper stretch and edged away under steady right hand encouragement. OFFICER IPOD sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch and continued on well to hold the place. VINEYARD HAVEN steadied behind horses along the backstretch, angled four wide while gaining on the turn, lodged a bid to challenge leaving the quarter pole then drifted to the inside while weakening in the late stages. PHOSPHORESCENT prompted the early pace from outside, lodged a bid bid between horses at the top of the stretch and steadied slightly while giving way in upper stretch.
