A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 may be made at time of entry. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. A bonus of \$100,000 will go to the owner of the first two-year-old purchased at the 2009 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Yearlings sale to win a graded stake at Saratoga (The Schuylerville, The Sanford, The Adirondack, The Saratoga Special, The With Anticipation, The Spinaway or The Three Chimneys Hopeful). 121lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 2lbs.; Maidens, 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 10, 2010 with 24 Nominations. (Cloudy 82)

Bay Gelding, (Jan), by Sunday Break (JPN) - Majestic Mommy by Olympio. Trainer Maker J. Michael. Bred by Arthellor Scisney & Carolyn Scisney (KY).

MAYBESOMAYBENOT showed good speed and set the pace under some urging, vied inside on the turn, shook off **ANOTHER SILVER OAK** near the furlong marker and edged clear under right hand urging. **NACHO SAINT** was urged along near the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out a bit in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. **ANOTHER SILVER OAK** chased the pace on the outside, made a bid near the five-sixteenth pole, vied into the final furlong and weakened while clear for the show. **LOU BRISSIE** bumped lightly with **CHIPSHOT** near the five-eighths pole, was urged along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. **CHIPSHOT** was bumped in the hindquarters near the five-eighths pole, raced just off the pace while urged along, came two to three wide into the stretch and capitulated. **BAIL OUT THE CAT** acted-up just before the start, broke very awkwardly, hit the gate and had the rider lose his right iron for a few strides, spotted the field open lengths, raced well back in the field, shifted four wide into the stretch and was no factor. **BLUE RIGHT BY** was urged along towards the rear, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. **COMMONWEALTH RUSH** tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired.
