DIXIE MEISTER chased inside then a bit off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied to the front under urging between foes in deep stretch and held gamely. ARMENIAN SUMMER settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch, came out again in upper stretch and closed willingly. PREACHINATTHEBAR stalked the pace inside then off the rail, bid four wide on the second turn, gained the advantage into the stretch, fought back three deep in midstretch, could not match the top pair late but held third. BUCKLAND MANOR chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPELLBINDER prompted the pace three deep then between foes on the second turn and into the stretch, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened late. CHEROOT had speed outside rivals then angled in, dueled inside, dropped back into the stretch, came out in midstretch and also weakened. DECLAN'S MOON forced the pace between horses, put a head in front on the second turn, fought back a bit off the inside into the stretch and along the rail in midstretch and also weakened late.
