Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over since July 7, 2012, allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over OR Two Grade III races at One Mile or Over since January 6, 2012, 5 lbs. COIL stalked the pace off the rail, came out some into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in the drive, gained a slim advantage past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under urging. ULTIMATE EAGLE had good early speed off the rail, pulled some and set the pace just off the fence or inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and went willingly to the wire. JOHN SCOTT chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and just held third. TRES BORRACHOS saved ground chasing the pace throughout and was edged for the show. BANK THE EIGHT three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival or between horses, continued alongside a foe on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. JAYCITO pulled his way along and came out into and on the first turn, tugged his way up three deep on the backstretch, lugged out and dropped back on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased.
