TUSCAN EVENING (IRE) took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail into and on the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and held on gamely under some urging and good handling. CAT BY THE TALE angled in and stalked off the rail or between foes, bid alongside the winner leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong but was second best. GENERAL CONSENSUS settled inside then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and edged a foe for the show. EISSOAI (BRZ) pulled hard under a hold while stalking the pace inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and was edged for third. BELMONT CAT (NZ) a bit slow to begin, pulled early, chased outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. APRIL PRIDE (GB) bobbed at the start, also pulled early, stalked outside then three deep to the stretch and weakened in the drive. TREAT GENTLY (GB) pulled her way along between foes and was in tight early, chased just off the rail on the backstretch and second turn and also weakened. CHASIN DREAMS saved ground chasing the pace throughout and had no response in the stretch.
