STORMY LUCY broke a bit slowly, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up on the wire. MISS SERENDIPITY (ARG) stalked the pace inside, came out three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and held on well but was caught late. CHANGETHECHANNEL stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, fell back some between horses in midstretch then edged a rival for the show. CHAMPAGNEANDCAVIAR chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was outfinished late for third. PHONYBOOKSNRECORDS sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came out some into the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and weakened. FLORAL ROMANCE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TOPIC allowed to settle off the rail then outside a rival, also came out into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. CUSTOMER BASE hopped at the start, settled outside a rival then inside chasing the pace, steadied in tight off heels in midstretch and could not summon the necessary late response.
