AMEN HALLELUJAH chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes in the drive, gained a short lead under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. FRANNY FREUD stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn, bid three deep into the stretch, put a head in front, fought back between horses through a long drive and held second. SWITCH angled in and dueled outside a rival, inched away into the turn, continued just off the inside, fought back inside foes through the drive, drifted in some late and bested the others. WHISPERING HUSH settled a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHE'S FUNOMENAL had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the turn, fell back some into the stretch and weakened. SERIOUSLY saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving turn and into the stretch and lacked a response in the drive.
