AWESOME BABY bumped after the start, had good early speed and dueled outside the runner-up, inched away into the stretch, kicked clear, drifted inward in the final sixteenth but held gamely under some urging. TASTE LIKE CANDY also bumped just after the break, dueled inside the winner, had that one slip away into the stretch, angled off the rail a sixteenth out and came back on late. CRUSHED VELVET broke in a bit, chased off the rail, came out under urging into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive, was floated out a bit a sixteenth from the wire and lacked the needed late kick. UZZIEL hopped slightly then was bumped between horses and squeezed back just after the start, pulled and raced greenly behind horses with her head in the air and was taken off the inside on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn and into the stretch, fell farther back and was eased in the final furlong.
