upper stretch, responded when challenged in midstretch, edged away again under urging a sixteenth out, drifted out slightly in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. EXAGGERATOR stalked outside a rival then three deep on the turn, was fanned out into the stretch, bid outside the winner in

midstretch, could not quite match that one in the final sixteenth, was a bit crowded behind that rival in deep stretch but continued willingly to be second best. DENMAN'S CALL stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, continued along the rail in the stretch and also went on willingly to the end. SHEIKH OF SHEIKHS angled in and dueled outside the winner, was three deep between horses into the stretch and weakened. EL

CHARRO settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out a bit into the stretch and lacked a further response.
