XCHANGER rated off the pace toward the outside, advanced his position widest through the turn, was six wide entering the lane, bumped off stride while taking the lead in midstretch, dug in gamely from there and inching away from the top two. ACTIN GOOD rated close to the pace about the three path, assumed a short lead midway through the turn, ducked out making solid contact with Xchanger nearing the eighth pole, continued in a game duel from there though reluctantly yielding toward the wire. BUFFALO MAN rated close to the pace inside, eased three wide looking for room between horses leaving the quarter pole then dueled close to deep stretch before yielding the final seventy yards. AIR LORD maintained position just off the rail through the backstretch, was boxed in losing momentum approaching the turn, angled widest leaving the quarter pole and finished strong. DATRICK rated a pressured pace two deep, dug in between horses through the turn to remain a factor then weakened passing the eighth pole. KING BARNEY rated just off the early pace about six wide, gave chase through the turn then had nothing left in the stretch. FIRST CAVALRY pressured the pace from the inside, maintained a presence on the rail through the turn then weakened entering the stretch. A claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner up, was dismissed
