MADMAN DIARIES set the pace on the inside, came off the rail approaching the stretch, dug in gamely between rivals in deep stretch and held on well. **VENGEFUL WILDCAT** stumbled badly at the start, chased three wide, bid outside at the quarter pole, moved up alongside the winner in midstretch and finished gamely outside. **CHIPSHOT** raced between rivals, three wide on the turn, angled in in upper stretch and finished well inside. **MAYBESOMAYBENOT** stalked three wide, came four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. **NACHO SAINT** raced off the pace inside, came four wide into the lane and had no rally. **J J'S LUCKY TRAIN** raced off the rail, five wide past the quarter pole and lacked a rally. **PRINTING PRESS** tracked inside, moved up to challenge nearing the turn and weakened. **ANOTHER SILVER OAK** chased in the two path, raced between rivals on the turn and tired.
