Dark Bay or Brown Gelding, (Feb), by Broken Vow - Yard by Boundary. Trainer McLaughlin P. Kiaran. Bred by Indian Creek(KY). LETHAL COMBINATION dropped back after the start, raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear, closed the gap with a half-mile to run, advanced three wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed well in unison with TURF MELODY while under right hand urging, battled with that rival in the final furlong and prevailed while under strong hand urging late. TURF MELODY was a bit rank while inside in the early going, saved ground while reserved on the first turn, moved closer with a half-mile to run, was kept on hold while behind horses early on the far turn, came under a ride and gathered momentum when joined by LETHAL COMBINATION near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed well alongside the winner, battled with that rival in the final furlong and missed while clear for the place. FANTASTICO ROBERTO (IRE) disputed the early advantage with DEVON ROCK, vied inside of that rival on the first turn, conceded the lead entering the backstretch, moved out and tracked the leader, came under urging with a half-mile to run, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn, made a brief bid between rivals passing the furlong marker then weakened while just able to get the show. MYSTIC was reserved on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went three wide on the far turn, was given his cue coming to the quarter-pole, made a brief bid between rivals passing the furlong marker then also weakened but just missed the show. CITRUS KID moved in before the first turn, settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, steadied nearing the quarter-pole, tried to come through a tight opening on the hedge approaching the furlong marker, didn't have enough room, hit the hedge and steadied then dropped out in a tough trip. DEVON ROCK disputed the early lead on the outside of FANTASTICO ROBERTO, moved clear leaving the first turn, set the pace through quick fractions, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and faded. (Rail at Hedge)
