WORLD APPROVAL dropped in at the rear of the field, was unhurried along the hedge, moved up some midway down the backstretch, bided his time patiently while continuing to save ground on the far turn, cut the corner while roused into the stretch, rallied through a clear hedge opening, made a bid at the eighth-pole, battled with the runner-up under a left-handed whip in the final furlong and gamely prevailed in a perfect trip. MONEY MULTIPLIER was taken in hand along the hedge, tossed his head briefly late on the first turn, settled more kindly on the backstretch, drafted inside on the far turn, spun off the rail when asked at the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, gained a short lead, battled determinedly with the winner under a right-handed whip in the final furlong and just missed. GO AROUND bumped with WINTER SPRINGS just after the start then was taken back, went around the first turn in the two path, was reserved near the back, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, advanced quickly on the outside, made a bid under a left-handed whip at the furlong marker but was out-kicked by the top two while well clear for the show. NONNA'S BOY went to the front, set the quick pace on the inside, was asked at the quarter-pole then came under one crack of a right-handed whip, switched to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths, lost the lead before the furlong marker and weakened. WINTER SPRINGS (FR) bumped with GO AROUND after the start then was taken back between horses, raced inside under a snug hold on the first turn then was reserved off the pace, went around the far turn in the two path, was asked at the quarter-pole, chased under one crack of a right-handed whip while behind horses in upper stretch, dropped in at the furlong marker then tired. TAKEOVER TARGET was tucked into the two path on the first turn then reserved on the outside, advanced four wide on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch into contention but came up empty. VISION PERFECT was asked from the gate, raced in the two path on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, was asked at the seven-sixteenths, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and capitulated. SKY HERO bobbed slightly after the start, tracked the pace on the outside while racing in the two path, was put to a drive coming to the quarter-pole, floated three wide into the stretch and stopped.
