INSPECTOR LYNLEY took up residence in the pocket after the break, was kept on hold keeping watch on the front runners, forced to bide time during the final stages of the run around the far turn, became entrapped in a blind switch approaching the guarter pole, after the runner up rushed up three wide at that stage, sealing off any possible route to the outside, kept interest lightly hand urged from upper to midstretch, but still in the previously-described snare, was allowed to drop back, the only way out, leaving the furllong marker, deftly altered course into the four path at

the sixteenth marker, placing herself to the left of all the front runners, kicked into her best at the conclusion of the maneuver, rolling by in the final jumps to prove best. CAMELOT KITTEN saved ground for the opening six furlongs, picked up interest (and speed) when let out a notch, teamed

up with STRIKE MIDNIGHT, also intent to move outward at that juncture, out-raced that foe into the three path, spun into the stretch and was switched over to a drive, vied with vigor as the widest of a threesome until the shadow of the wire, may have poked a head down in front

momentarily in the last stages before having the eventual winner zoom by. ISOTHERM assumed a forward spot by the end of the homestretch, was patiently ridden stalking RAY'S THE BAR from the two path, began to narrow in as three-quarters was being run, got set down after settling into upper stretch, battled hard and willingly from between rivlas but had to settle for the show. RAY'S THE BAR (GB) away well, grabbed control and cut over to the rail prior to the beginning of the first turn, got rated while attended by ISOTHERM parked out in path two, got turned loose at the quarter pole as a three-ply tussle for the front commenced, held out with determination before weakening late. STRIKE MIDNIGHT raced two wide, between rivals early on the clubhouse turn, got cued up and proceeded to angle to the outside shortly after entering the far turn, lost position

to the second place finisher and wound up in the four path, got called upon for the drive home and had no rally. CALL PROVISION was steadied after being squeezed shortly after the start, raced three wide on both turns, was through after going six furlongs.
