RAGING BULL (FR) settled just off the inside just off the pace behind the cover of HOT SPRINGS, remained patiently handled until put to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled out five wide into upper stretch, offered up a good kick to issue a challenge through the final eighth collaring the leader just inside the sixteenth pole, then inched away to the finish to prevail. UP THE ANTE broke out at the start filling the space vacated by the slower breaking MARCH TO THE ARCH and forcing that foe to be taken in hand when taking over his lane, established the front and slipped away just off the inside through the first turn before settling in hand down the backstretch through moderate splits, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths as the field advanced, swung three wide into upper stretch, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under threat from a pair, got collared inside the sixteenth marker and ran on to preserve the place honors on the wire. MARCH TO THE ARCH broke half a beat slow and was steadied at the start behind UP THE ANTE who took over the lane conceding four lengths to the front, saved ground at the rear of the field early on, came under light coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, darted to the two path nearing the eighth pole and ran on with good energy to be clear for the show honors. HOT SPRINGS coaxed from the gate, raced three wide into the opening bend before tucking to the two path midway forwardly placed and in close aim of the leader, remained in hand down the backstretch until put to coaxing half a mile from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, kept on for the last major share. GOLDEN BROWN brushed the near side stall at the start getting away a step slow, tracked the pace along the inside in close range and behind the cover of the leader, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, weakened in the final furlong. SAND DANCER coaxed from the gate, raced three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under a ride at the seven-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. THERAPIST three wide through the first turn, settled four wide in the clear and near the rear of the field, came under coaxing and advanced at the seven-sixteenths to mid pack while five wide, continued five wide into upper stretch and weakened. FREE DROP BILLY four wide through the first turn, settled three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch and weakened. MARAUD three wide into the opening bend, raced four to five wide in the clear and near the rear of the field, came under light coaxing into the far turn and got out to be seven wide midway on that bend despite a hard near sided hold and off sided stick correction, swung four wide into upper stretch and was unable to make any impact.
