GLOBAL ACCESS away without apparent mishap, travelled three wide on the clubhouse bend, tipped one farther off the hedge swinging onto the backstretch, sat reserved during the run around the far turn, came four wide into the lane and was given his cue, clawed his way towards the front runners, latching on to them and igniting a spirited three-way tussle for the top, participating in it as the outermost one, came in slightly leaving the sixteenth pole as the runner up was coming out slightly itself at the same time, bumped lightly with that foe, by this juncture with each on near even terms with the other, gained clearance from GOOD GOVERNANCE when that opponent lugged in a bit two jumps later, fought on with good courage and proved best. GOOD GOVERNANCE (GB) well rated taking up the chase from the two path during the initial stages, went into path three for entrance onto the backstretch, was in the same departing it, kept watch on the front runners within striking distance, ranged up to begin vying outside them from the general area of the five-sixteenths marker, stepped into the lane strongly contending for the top, got asked for more springing from the three-sixteenths pole, emerged at the eighth pole clutching to a narrow lead, but forced to defend it in between opponents, wandered out a bit towards the middle of the strip with approximately a sixteenth to go, being intermittently fed left side stick work at the time, met up with then bumped lightly with the winner inside the final seventy yards, seemingly self-corrected by lugging in a bit during the next two strides, negatively impacting RINALDI however, fought with determination to the bitter end but wound up denied. SEISMIC WAVE glided over to the hedge shortly after the start, closed the gap as the pace softened significantly on the backstretch, became keen and was lightly steadied as POWER PLAYER was also having the brakes tapped right around the three-eighths pole, bided time professionally afterwards to the quarter pole, was under urging tipping into path two at the head of the stretch, rallied for the show. RINALDI took up the role of primary pursuer after the field had been sent off and running, undertaking it in the two path, found itself between rivals coming up the five-sixteenths pole once the runner up arrived on the scene, got turned loose spinning into the lane, fought well but wasn't able to claim the front end, was still vying with vigour in deep stretch when induced to shy over to the inside route with less than seventy yards to go, suffered some loss of momentum, then fell a head short of snagging third. POWER PLAYER the quickest out of the gate, was pulling on the bit kicking well clear of the competition early, saw the others close in readily after being given a breather on the backstretch, picked up speed after the second fraction had been finalized, had edged away from the rest by about two lengths when taken hold of midway on turn two, stopped pulling, only to come under pressure from a pair of rivals parked out two and three wide respectively right afterwards, was still arguing with them when put to a drive heading home, relinquished for good a little while later and backed away.
