**1 3/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:513) STAKES. Purse \$750,000 Saratoga Oaks Invitational S. AN INVITATIONAL FOR FILLIES, THREE-YEARS-OLD. In order to be eligible for entry into the Saratoga Oaks Invitational, horses accepting an invitation must make a pre-entry payment of \$6,000 (USD) no later than 1:00 PM (EDT) on Wednesday, June 24th. An entry fee of \$6,000 (USD) will be due at time of entry. The purse for the Saratoga Oaks Invitational shall be divided as follows: \$400,000 to the owner of the winner, \$140,000 to second, \$75,000 to third, \$50,000 to fourth, \$30,000 to fifth, \$22,500 to sixth, \$17,500 to seventh and \$15,000 to eighth. Weight: 121 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the Main Track). (Clear 82)**

CONCRETE ROSE got away cleanly to a forward position and was relinquished the front just after the start as OLENDON was put to a firm hold and wrangled to track inside, showed the way under a firm rated hold just off the inside through the opening bend and down the backstretch through sensible splits uncontested and under no pressure, had CORAL BEACH make the first attempt placed to light coaxing three furlongs from home and was given a notch to slip back away after briefly being latched on to into the far turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, got shaken up straightened away and drew off under a vigorous hand drive to the sixteenth marker before being geared down to prevail comfortably on the wire. HAPPEN away to a sluggish beginning brushing the near side stall, settled along the inside past the stands for the initial time and through the first turn before taking to the three path down the backstretch taking up cover behind her barn mate down the backstretch, remained on hold until called upon at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive proving no match for the top one while keeping on to just nose a rival at the finish to secure the place honors. KELSEY'S CROSS settled just off the inside at the tail of the compact field albeit in striking range of the front under a firm hold past the stands and through the opening bend before taking up cover behind HAPPEN three wide down the backstretch, tucked inside with seven-sixteenths to go, came under a ride five-sixteenths from home and went two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive getting put briefly in tight a furlong out as OLENDON came inwards sustaining a bump from CORAL BEACH near that station, lost no momentum and continued the drive despite the tight seam and kept on to just miss for the place honors while never threatening the winner. CORAL BEACH (IRE) broke in at the start and was corrected, settled just off the inside in range of the leader through the first turn, took to the three path and raced in closest aim of the leader in the clear down the backstretch, came under light coaxing into the far turn before being put to urging at the three-eighths briefly latching on CONCRETE ROSE and applying tepid pressure before being shaken off through the latter portion of that turn, swung four wide for home, came in under an off sided stick bumping OLENDON nearing the eighth pole and was outkicked to the finish. OLENDON (FR) broke on top and was put to a hard rating hold conceding the front and growing rank past the stands and into the first turn while along the inside, took to the two path down the backstretch taking loose cover behind CONCRETE ROSE settling better with five and a half furlongs remaining, tucked inside at the seven-sixteenths, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, bid mildly between foes nearing the eighth pole and was bumped as CORAL BEACH came in under an off sided stick, then weakened in the late stages. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the stretch run as well as a Jockey's Objection by the rider of OLENDON alleging interference against CORAL BEACH. After review, the objection was dismissed and the result stood prior to the race being declared official.
