COPPER BULLET just off the top pair four wide, came under light coaxing tucked three wide into the turn advancing to latch on the duel and vie stacked three wide three furlongs from home, took over command nearing the quarter pole, and swung four wide at that station, drew clear under a drive kept to task to the wire. HOLLYWOOD STAR off a step slow albeit without incident, chased two to three wide from near the rear, began to advance into the turn and came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, rallied with good energy to chase the winner home proving no match for that one on this day while along clear for the place honors second best. TEMPESTAD chased three to four wide coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to run, tucked to the two path midway on the turn, cut the corner into upper stretch and tipped out to the three path immediately after straightening away, offered up a mild kick shying out under a near sided stick and bumping with CREAS' BKLYN LAW inside the eighth pole and bested that rival as well as another at the finish to secure the show honors. BAL HARBOUR bumped at the start by MO DIDDLEY who broke inwards, chased just off the pace along the inside under encouragement with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on through the stretch to garner the last major share. CREA'S BKLYN LAW off half a beat slow, came under coaxing and chased two to three wide from near the rear, got ridden along with seven-sixteenths to go, angled four to five wide at the quarter pole, rallied and was bumped by TEMPESTAD just inside the eighth pole as that rival shied out from the stick, offered up a mild kick but as bested for major shares. DIAMOND OOPS stumbled at the start, chased three wide in mid pack, came under a ride seven-sixteenths from home, went six wide at the head of the stretch and tired. MO DIDDLEY broke in at the start bumping BAL HARBOUR, prompted BARRY LEE along the inside before advancing to duel with that rival down the backstretch and into the turn, got joined outside by the eventual winner three deep and came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, got displaced in tandem nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home and tired in the stretch. BARRY LEE broke in brushing the near side stall and came under hustling to lead early on from the three path, dueled with MO DIDDLEY headed for command from the five-eighths, came under coaxing tucked in the two path when joined outside by COPPER BULLET at the three-eighths, vied between foes through the latter portion of the turn and was displaced in tandem by that rival and shaken off spinning three wide into upper stretch before folding in the drive. VINO chased just off the inside in mid pack early on, tucked inside half a mile out, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, faded through the latter portion of the turn and swung five wide at the top of the lane, then gave way in the stretch.
