Bay Colt, (Jan), by Friesan Fire - Avani Force by Forestry. Trainer Jason Servis. Bred by Beatrice Patterson & Vicky Schowe (PA). CALL PAUL got bumped at the start by MEADE who broke inwards twice and in turn bumped very lightly with SPINOFF, vied inside a pair early on from the two path until taking sole command five furlongs from home, briefly held a safe advantage until TIGHT TEN latched on to the outside once more half a mile from home as SPINOFF backed away, came under light coaxing tucked inside through the turn, spun just off the inside for home roused for the stretch drive, got bumped off stride as TIGHT TEN lugged in at the three-sixteenths, came under a near sided stick brushing with that rival a furlong from home, dug in gamely through to the finish coming very slightly outwards to brush his main danger a sixteenth from home and prevailed safely on the wire drifting very slightly being show a near sided stick in the last jumps. TIGHT TEN bobbled at the start recovering to the lead very early on from the four path before vying with a pair to his inside until headed five furlongs from home, advanced to press the pace tucking to the two path into the turn, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, lugged in straightened away bumping CALL PAUL off stride at the three-sixteenths, dug in latched on to the eighth pole and was brushed as CALL PAUL came outwards very slightly, dug in fighting on through to the finish getting brushed once more near the sixteenth marker before beginning to be shaken off in the last strides to the wire getting floated very lightly as the winner shied very slightly from the visual of a near sided stick. SPINOFF ranged up shortly after the start to vie from the three path between foes down the backstretch until shaken off a bit with five furlongs to go, tucked inside half a mile from home and got briefly taken in hand near the seven-sixteenths before being coaxed along once more, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and ran on to close in late while along clear for the show honors. MEADE broke out at the start bumping CALL PAUL twice despite being corrected, raced inside early on until tipped out six furlongs from home to take to the four or five path down the backstretch, came under coaxing half a mile from home, tucked three wide into the turn, advanced mildly outside through the bend, swung four wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch.
