CATHERINETHEGREAT came away in good order, set the pace under pressure, controlled the action in the two path on the turn, kicked clear under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and drew off under strong urging. NONNA MADELINE broke a step slow, moved up to be well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths, shifted three wide into the stretch, chased the winner under the whip into the final furlong and proved no match while able to get the place. CONGRATS GAL brushed with a rival at the start then was hustled, raced just off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was ridden along in the two path on the turn, dropped to the rail and cut the corner into the stretch and lacked the needed response while well clear for the show. SERENGETI EMPRESS was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the turn, had the rider lose his whip while four wide into the stretch, dropped back under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. LADY APPLE was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, dropped back under a drive past the three-sixteenths and tired. EYEINTHESKY bobbled inward at the start, was reserved towards the rear, went around the turn in the three path, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. FIGHTRESS bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along off the pace, raced inside on the turn and retreated. LONELY ROAD was bumped on both sides at the start, settled near the back, was urged along in the two path on the turn, came four wide into the stretch under the whip and was no factor. TAPPING PEARL was bumped on both sides at the start then dropped to the rear, came under urging inside the five-eighths, went around the turn in the three path and also failed to respond. BLAME THE FROG was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, floated seven wide into the stretch and faltered.
