SHOWING UP set the pace from the inside after a good start, was under mild pressure for a half, shook loose on the second turn and finished under a mild drive. IVAN DENISOVICH (IRE) lacked speed while racing along the inside, was forced to come four wide into the stretch and rallied for the place but could not reach the winner. PRIMARY broke outward, raced off the rail near the middle of the field and lodged a mild bid in the stretch. PROUDINSKY (GER) raced close up along the inside then weakened a bit in the drive. NIAGARA CAUSEWAY lacked speed off the rail and made a mild bid in the stretch but flattened out. GO BETWEEN raced close up off the rail and gave way on the final turn. (Race run in lane 5, rail at 0.).
