OSCAR PERFORMANCE broke inward and bumped with PERMIAN, shook it off and got up to stalk the pace while running in the three path, maintained his position along the backstretch then vied for the lead at the quarter pole and kicked clear with a furlong to go. TAJ MAHAL (IRE) sat well rated off the pace while running in the two path around the first turn, stayed not far off the leader up the backstretch then swung for home in the three path, uncorked a strong rally down the lane but needed more. AFANDEM (FR) dwelt in the gate then got into stride to track the pace on the inside, took the first turn in the two path, held his spot through the backstretch and the turn for home, ran all out when asked for more but did not have enough. SONIC BOOM bumped with PERMIAN at the start then quickly recovered to take a comfortable lead, stayed in the two path around the turns, dug in when collared at the quarter pole but grew tired. GORGEOUS KITTEN ground broke from under him at the start then he was content to trail the field, swung for home in the four path but was no match. PERMIAN (IRE) got pinched back at the start getting bumped by SONIC BOOM and OSCAR PERFORMANCE, tracked the pace in the three path around both turns, had no response when asked for more then broke down after the finish and was euthanized.
