Purse \$600,000 SHADWELL TURF MILE S.(GRADE I) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$400 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$30,000 at the time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$3,000 to enter and an additional \$3,000 to start with \$ 600,000 guaranteed, of which \$372,000 to the owner of the winner, \$120,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth and \$18,000 to fifth. Weight: Three year olds, 123 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Wednesday, September 27, 2006 with 19 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track. (Clear 61)

AUSSIE RULES, slow to start, settled three wide, remained near the inside when advancing on the far turn, came out to rally from between rivals when straightened into the stretch five wide, finished fast and drove clear very late. REMARKABLE NEWS (VEN) chased front-running OLD DODGE (BRZ) from early on while three or four wide, loomed menacingly through the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner at the end while out-gaming that one for second. OLD DODGE (BRZ), backed into the starting gate, gained the advantage early, moved in two or three wide, held a slight edge into the stretch and grudgingly weakened. MIESQUE'S APPROVAL settled near the inside, eased out to make a run five or six wide leaving the second turn but lacked a serious late bid while dead-heating with COSMONAUT for fourth. COSMONAUT followed the leaders four wide, moved wider when rallying into the stretch, loomed prominently for the drive but came up empty while finishing on even terms with MIESQUE'S APPROVAL for fourth. THREE VALLEYS, outrun and five wide for six furlongs moved wider for the drive but lacked the needed response. SILENT NAME (JPN) saved ground until approaching the stretch, swung out ten wide for the drive but never threatened. HENDRIX weakened nearing the stretch. BRITISH BLUE gained a forward position early while maneuvering in two or three wide, raced in contention to the stretch and weakened.
