MARCHMAN set the pressured pace toward the inside, edged clear entering the stretch, fought on through a prolonged drive and maintained a diminishing advantage. POSITIVE SIDE settled between horses, took closer order through the turn, angled to the inside with three-sixteenths to run, quickened and was getting to the winner with every stride. SOMETHING EXTRA attended the pace along the inside, shifted out four wide entering the stretch to be clear, continued on well but was unable to bridge the gap. HOGY settled under a snug hold angled out six wide leaving the turn, was bumped and carried out further but kept on willingly. GO BLUE OR GO HOME disputed the pace three wide, but faltered between rivals in the final furlong and faded. GANTRY was allowed to settle, came five wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to make headway through the drive. HAVELOCK broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride, swung to the outside leaving the turn and was making up ground. SHRINKING VIOLET settled saving ground, got through but lacked the needed late response. NO SILENT broke slow, moved up five wide, drifted out leaving the turn, bumped with HOGY in the upper stretch and flattened. CHANNEL MARKER saved ground to no avail. ANIMAL STYLE failed to respond. ANCIL was close up three wide to the stretch and dropped out.
