Bay Colt, (Mar), by Tiznow - Sweet Damsel by Turkoman. Trainer Harty G. Eoin. Bred by WinStar Farm, LLC(KY). COLONEL JOHN stalked the early pace then bid outside a rival, dueled outside that one and briefly between foes on the backstretch, gained the advantage into the stretch, inched away past midstretch and held on gamely under urging and strong handling. EL GATO MALO pulled a bit early, stalked the pace inside, waited some off heels leaving the second turn then came out three deep into the stretch and finished well. VICTORY PETE took the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened late but held third. REFLECT TIMES (JPN) three deep on the first turn, bid three wide on the backstretch then stalked outside the runner-up, came out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SUCCESS FEE bobbed slightly at the start, chased between horses then a bit off the rail, dropped back into the second turn and gave way in the stretch.
