HOLIDAY SOIREE underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, steadily advanced into contention, lightly hand urged, turned for home and got called upon, outkicked a pair of rivals during the next furlong to arrive at the furlong marker as the clear leader, extended the margin primarily under a vigorous hand ride. DELIGHTFUL QUALITY put to brisk hand urging leaving the gate, had the pilot change tactics once FIVE STAR MOMMA had established control and subsequently settle towards the inside, tracked that rival from the pocket, picked up interest and closed in noticeably during the later stages of the run around the bend, cut the corner, poised to strike, but lacking optimal clearance, got shuffled back, chose to alter course with a bit less than a furlong to go, got stymied a second time, nudged APROPOS aside enough to finally gain room to rally, was given her cue and did so, finishing with a flourish, but too late to seriously challenge the top one. FIVE STAR MOMMA grabbed the advantage shortly after the start, took up residence at a slight distance from off the rail, set the pace feeling the presence of the closest pursuers, had the pressure intensify immensely just shy of a half, was more in the two path than along the inside entering the lane, drifted inward gradually from upper to midstretch, all the while forcing DELIGHTFUL QUALITY, pinned on the rail at this juncture, to be kept on hold while losing valuable ground, clamped down the rail for good midway between the three-sixteenths marker and the eighth pole, kept up a fight for the lead with another twosome that had began at the head of the stretch for a little while longer before weakening into the show slot. WELL KEPT out broke the field by a half length but was soon overhauled by FIVE STAR MOMMA, stalked that rival from the outside, with another duo, one parked out three wide and the other down along the fence in close proximity, has that quartet congregate at the quarter pole, fought for the lead from between rivals racing through the furlong grounds, fell back slightly but quickly altered course to the outside, doing so just as the second place was attempting the same maneuver and inadvertently crossing over into that foe's path, weakened steadily thereafter. APROPOS got away two beats slowly, was patiently handled proceeding down the backstretch, took up the chase on the front runners from the two path on the turn, swung four wide into the lane under solid urging, got leaned upon by the runner up as that opponent desperately tried to angle outward in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, continued onward but made no impact.
