OBVIOUSLY (IRE) sped to the early lead, inched away into the first turn, set the pace inside, opened up on the second turn, widened under left handed urging in the stretch and held. SUMMER FRONT angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside in the stretch and edged rivals for the place. TOM'S TRIBUTE broke a bit slowly and steadied when crowded early, settled off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and just got a share of the show. SILENTIO chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and held a share of third. JACK MILTON chased inside then outside a rival on the backstretch, split horses on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for a minor award. WINNING PRIZE (ARG) drifted out into the first turn, angled in and stalked a bit off the rail to the stretch and weakened. PULPIT'S EXPRESS fanned wide into the first turn, angled in and stalked outside a rival, dropped back outside on the second turn and gave way.
