NEEDS SUPERVISION raced in the four path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, stalked the leader in the three path on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, took the lead while put to a drive in upper stretch and proved best under steady urging. ERES TU went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, started the far turn in the two path, angled out at the five-sixteenths and bumped COWGIRLS LIKE US, came five wide into the stretch, made an outside bid at the three-sixteenths, battled with the winner in the final furlong and hung then couldn't get by but was well clear for the place. GRANDARIA went two to three wide on the first turn, came out entering the backstretch, settled towards the rear, went three to four wide on the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. LIORA hit the outside of the gate at the start and was off a half-step slow, raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside of the leader, rounded the far turn in the two path, took the lead at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner and tired. COWGIRLS LIKE US broke out and brushed the gate then bumped with a rival, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced three wide early on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths then bumped by ERES TU, moved to the four then five path shortly thereafter, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. MANDY BLUE was bumped at the start, angled in at the rear, went three to four wide on the first turn, was carried out onto the backstretch, settled at the rear, went two to three wide on the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, came five wide into the stretch, drifted out near the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. FUN FINDER went to the front, was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, lost the lead at the guarter-pole and faded.
