DANISH DYNAFORMER broke inwards and bumped into ALDOUS SNOW at the start, raced in midpack, was two-wide on the opening

turn, kept position down the backstretch, angled three-wide at the 3/8ths pole, headed the leaders past the 3/16ths pole and proved best.

HARDEST CORE tracked the early leader, saved ground on the opening turn, angled two-wide at the 7/16ths pole, headed the pacesetter at 1/4 pole, dueled down the stretch but was outfinished. ALDOUS SNOW was bumped by DANISH DYNAFORMER at the start, raced in midpack on

the inside, angled two-wide nearing the 3/8ths pole, lacked a path early in the stretch, found room, launched a bid, came out and bumped into GENEROUS KITTEN in the late yards and finished gamely. GENEROUS KITTEN raced near the back early, was two-wide on the opening turn,

raced two and three-wide on the far turn, rallied in the stretch, was bumped by ALDOUS SNOW late but was game to the wire. MONEY TALKER set the pace, extended his lead down the backstretch, saved ground, was headed early in the stretch, dueled and gave way grudgingly. AMI'S HOLIDAY trailed the field early, angled to the rail approaching the opening turn, was well back from the leaders down the backstretch, saved ground through most of the far turn, angled to the far outside turning for home but was never a threat. MR GRUMPY showed brief speed, stalked

the pace along the inside, saved ground on the turn, lost touch with the leaders down the backstretch, continued to save ground on the far turn and weakened in stretch. THE RIDER OF GENEROUS KITTEN LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST ALDOUS SNOW FOR THE BUMPING INCIDENT IN LATE STRETCH. HOWEVER, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH. Owners- 2, Charles E.
