CLASS LEADER leaned in slightly when put in close nearing the first turn and exchanged bumps with **STARRY MOON**, settled well off the early pace while removed from the inside, came under pressure into the far turn, circled four wide making headway past the quarter pole, angled out a bit wider in upper stretch, made a grinding run under left handed rousing, collared the dueling leaders in deep stretch, switched to his left lead, forged ahead and held sway. **LIFE IN SHAMBLES** stalked the pace two wide under some rating, moved within himself to engage the leader leaving the far turn, poked a head in front after six furlongs, met an outside challenge entering the lane three wide, dueled, was put to left handed urging soon past the furlong grounds, held tenaciously to the late going but wasn't quite good enough. **SIX SPOT** rated kindly while saving ground in a forward position into the backstretch, angled three wide with five furlongs remaining, crept closer mid way on the final turn, bid four wide to engage **LIFE IN SHAMBLES** in upper stretch, went nose to nose with that one past the furlong pole, kept up the fight between runners with a sixteenth to go then faded. **SEA VIEW CHICO** saved ground advancing into the far turn, angled out to go around a tiring rival into the stretch, altered back in but lacked the needed finish. **STARRY MOON** broke a step slow, angled to the rail early, was jostled entering the first turn, came off the inside for the drive, shifted out wider past the eighth pole then continued with interest. **MASTER LIGHTNING**, three wide off the pace, came four wide for the drive but had no rally. **MR. ROVER** came in slightly nearing the first turn, angled in and gave way. **HE'S ACHANCE** angled in clearing then jumped tracks just past the wire the first time, jumped tracks again heading into the clubhouse turn, regrouped to set the pace along the rail, was overtaken after six furlongs then faltered in upper stretch.
