BACOPA BREEZE vied two wide, gained a short lead between rivals after three furlongs, took pressure to the quarter pole, spurted away in upper stretch, responded to strong handling through the final three sixteenths and held CO COLA at bay. CO COLA broke a step slow then settled in about the five path, dropped in a bit leaving the far turn, was asked to go on past the five sixteenths marker, shifted back out to five path entering the lane, was guided down towards the winner advancing past the furlong marker, kept on willingly but was denied. WHO'S IN TOWN bobbled at the break, recovered and moved up in the two path inside while inside rivals approaching the half mile pole, stalked around the turn, found room to advanced between runners three sixteenths out, continued a progression to mid stretch then failed to sustain in the final eighth. HENNY'S PRINCESS drafted back between rivals nearing the half mile marker, dropped to the rail for the run around the turn, worked out to about the five path making some headway past the three sixteenths marker then flattened out. HUG A TREE , away alertly, prompted the pace three wide, moved to challenge three furlongs out, disputed the pace outside foes to the head of the lane then gave way. HOP THE SIX set a pressured early pace along the rail, lost the lead after three furlongs, continued a forward presence to the top of the stretch then weakened. SILVER VALLEY came out some at the break, pursued early while between fillies then retreated after three furlongs.
