

# FIFTH RACE Saratoga August 30th, 2015

5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1:00<sup>2</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Smart N Fancy S.FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination: \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The Purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights: Three year olds, 120 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf in 2015, allowed 3 lbs.; of three Races on the turf other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races allowed 5 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday August 15, 2015 with 23 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.). (Cloudy 80)

LADY SHIPMAN coaxed from the gate, tracked the pace of TAHNEE to her inside through the first quarter mile before advancing to press that foe midway on the turn, spun just off the inside for home given her cue and took over three-sixteenths out, drew off under a light drive widening away, saw some of that cut into in hand late to the wire while establishing the course record time. FREE AS A BIRD perched three wide tracking the top pair in striking range, got set down continuing three wide into upper stretch, offered up a good kick through the drive which proved no match to reel in the top one while clear of the rest for the place honors. RUMBLE DOLL three wide at the rear, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, spun four wide at the quarter pole, offered up a good finish to close belatedly and just procured the show honors in the very last jump. TAHNEE hustled from the gate, cut swift fractions along the inside attended early on to the outside by the eventual winner, had that foe intensify the pressure midway on the turn, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch knocking heads with LADY SHIPMAN, got headed three-sixteenths from home and weakened in the late stages. SUGAR SHOCK chased the pace two to three wide, got set down nearing the quarter pole, swung just off the inside at that station and made no headway. KNIT ONE PURR TOO crossed to the inside after the break and chased inside through the turn ridden along from the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch, tired in the drive.
