Weights: 122lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 twice allowed 3 lbs.; \$40,000 once 5 lbs.; \$25,000 once 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming race s not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. TANZANITE CAT showed good speed away from the gate to be clear before a quarter off the inside, relinquished the advantage before a half, stalked into the far turn, engaged the leader from the outside turning for home, gained a slight lead nearing the furlong marker, edged clear under steady handling. WALT never far back after moving to the inside, made an early move to the front along the rail before a half, showed the way into and through the far turn, offered resistance to the winner when that one came alongside midway on that bend, proved stubborn in the drive, came in late under a right handed stick, second best. COASTLINE forwardly placed from the start, rated while remaining in good position in the three path throughout, set down when straightened for home, came up empty in lacking a late response. SON OF A PREACHER allowed to settle off the pace and the inside, in some traffic into the far turn, got closer entering the stretch two path, lacked a further response to finish up evenly. FIRE STARTER rank, steadied into the first turn, remained back under stout restraint onto the backstretch, improved when asked through the second turn, continued to display some late interest while well out in the strip. A STEP AHEAD bothered, carried out into the first turn, trailed far back, came four wide into the stretch, improved position. UNSTOPPABLE COLBY four wide in the first turn, fell back, picked off some tiring rivals while late while not a threat. DENALI RAHY RULER within striking distance in the three path, roused turning for home, gave way in the drive. D'CAJUN CAT broke alertly, allowed the pace to go, saved ground, faded in the drive. WHYRUAWESOME finished early, dull.
