

ELEVENTH RACE Gulfstream Park January 16th, 2016

1st MILE. (1:46⁴) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 Sunshine Millions Classic S.FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, BRED IN FLORIDA. Free nomination by Sunday, January 3. \$2,500 to enter and \$1,000 to start, with all starters to receive a \$1,000 rebate in addition to the purse. \$250,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake at a mile or over since July 1, allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over since July 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (Clear 73)

MEXIKOMA was reserved just off the leaders early, steadied nearing the seven-eighths pole, advanced four-wide through the second turn, moved up to engage MR. JORDAN nearing the sixteenth pole, was carried out by that drifting rival, responded and drew clear through the final yards. MR. JORDAN pressed the pace of ST. QUIQUEYANO while racing three-wide, moved up to take command nearing the five-eighths marker, opened a clear lead soon after, raced wide through the final turn, drifted out nearing the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly late. CATHOLIC COWBOY lacked early speed, moved three-wide through the second turn and finished with late interest. ROLL ON THE NAVAJO was void of early foot, raced three-wide through the second turn and finished evenly late. MORGANS HARBOUR was forwardly placed from the inside early, dropped back through the second turn, angled out nearing the quarter and passed tiring foes late. ABOUNDING LEGACY raced off the pacesetters early, moved up from between foes nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally in the drive. RUNS WITH BULLS was never far back while racing from between rivals, saved ground through the second turn and weakened in the drive. SARAGUARO was forwardly placed early, moved four-wide through the second turn and gradually weakened. YOURDREAMSORMINE was off a step slow then allowed to settle, raced three-wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. SR. QUIQUEYANO set a pressured pace from the inside for a half, stopped and was eased through the lane.
