HY RIVERSIDE was allowed to settle in opening stages then edged up between foes to stalk off the top flight, waited then roused between rivals leaving the far turn, dueled two wide in upper stretch, shook off inside foe and kept on with outside rivals, appeared to be defeated in deep stretch then dug back in tenaciously and put nose in front at the wire to prevail. NAUSET BEACH led the way in hand in the first turn then quickly came under pressure from PILOTING, remained comfortable dictating the pace by a narrow margin, began to edge away from aforementioned rival while taking on the outside challenge of AWESOME SLEW, dueled three wide between into the lane, refused to give up even through under pressure from the onset, fought gamely and got denied victory when rival put down a nose in front at the wire. AWESOME SLEW fanned out four wide in the first turn then raced under a snug hold and positioned along the outside in the second flight, commenced a steady bid in the far turn, moved up to the lead along the outside of NAUSET BEACH, dueled four wide into the lane, continued to battle heads apart then yielded in deep stretch. TIGER OF WALES secured inside position in the first turn then settled in stalking position off the top pair, made way through along the rail in the far turn, dueled along the inside in upper stretch, could not keep up the pace and flattened off the trio. PILOTING made way up in opening stages to apply pressure to NAUSET BEACH, continued to press the pace then vied along the outside, lost position midway through the far turn, moved to the outside of top flight in upper stretch and remained in range along the outside. WE'RE ALL SET was taken back in opening stages and continued settled back off the pace throughout the backstretch, roused along the outside at the quarter pole, showed response, raced widest of all but needed more to make late impact. UNCLE VINNY raced off the pace back five wide in the backstretch, came under a ride but failed to move
