JAY'S WAY hustled up bewteen rivals at the start and held narrow lead just off inside in the first turn, remained on top under snug hold with RICHARD THE GREAT applying some pressure, challenged by rival with added outside challenge of MR. JORDAN three furlongs from home, dueled along rail in far turn, lost edge to MR JORDAN but continued to fight back, moved out wider to race in close contact with rival then dug back in gamely, got by and held firm. MR. JORDAN was positioned well stalking top pair racing along outside in early stages, began to inch way up leaving the backstretch and up to challenge JAY'S WAY three furlongs out, dueled for the lead and took edge, drifted out at head of the lane, encouraged right handed and continued to battled with JAY'S WAY, rival took slim lead and refused to relinquish command, finished well clear over rest. CATHOLIC COWBOY was rated in early stages racing few paths off inside, shifted around and set down driving along far outside at head of the lane, was no match for pulling away top pair but gained and cleared the rest for share. RICHARD THE GREAT raced along outside in the first turn and raced just off JAY;S WAY prompting early pace, continued to apply pressure to rival then made move up to challenge when eventual winner roused forward near three eighths pole, dueled through far turn then failed to move on with pair and came out turning for home, steadily faded in the lane. FLEMISH CAP raced three to four wide in the first turn, settled in the back although never far from front end, hustled up for response in far turn, failed to move on. CROCODILE CHARLIE stalked along inside in early backstretch, began to lose some action and roused for more going by the half mile marker, failed to move on then dropped back, eased to wire, walked off.
