JOINT EFFORT angled in on the first turn and chased inside, moved up along the rail then came out leaving the second turn, gained the lead outside the runner-up nearing midstretch and pulled clear under urging. TAKE D' TOUR had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside, kicked clear on the second turn, battled inside the winner in midstretch and was second best. GETBACK TIME stalked inside then a bit off the rail, found the fence again into the stretch and edged a rival for third. DANCING GENERAL unhurried inside early, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at the show. SOMETHINABOUTLAURA off a bit slowly, chased outside, moved up three deep on the second turn and into the stretch but could not sustain the bid in the final furlong. BIT OF FOLLY three deep on the first turn, chased outside then alongside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SAFFRONISTA broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. FRIEL'S FOR REAL steadied off the heels of the winner into the first turn, chased inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and did not rally. YEARLY ATTITUDE pulled her way along and steadied into the first turn, angled in outside a rival then chased inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked a further response. PURRRFECTLY FITTING stalked outside a rival or off the rail and weakened in the stretch. NO SLEEP had speed between foes then dueled outside the runner-up, dropped back between horses on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. BENEFICIAL BARTOK unhurried off the rail early, dropped back into and on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
