Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by Montbrook - Riveting Drama by Notebook. Trainer Fawkes David. Bred by Harold L. Queen (FL). BIG DRAMA chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to hold MAMBO MEISTER safe. The latter, reserved after being steadied from close quarters at the start, saved ground around the turn, angled wide for racing room in the stretch and closed well for the place. HOW'S YOUR HALO chased the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run and couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. TAQARUB chased the pace, moved up to engage GO GO SHOOT entering the turn, vied with that rival to the quarter pole, then couldn't stay with the winner and gave way in the drive. SNAPSHOT tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and tired. CONGRESSIONAL PAGE rated off the pace, made a run to reach contention in the stretch, then faltered. CAUSEWAY'S KIN unhurried early, failed to menace. SINCERO was no factor after bumping with GATO GO WIN soon after the start. NOT FOR SILVER was outrun. GATO GO WIN bumped with SINCERO soon after the start, then saved ground to no avail. GOLDEN SPIKES well placed early, raced three wide around the turn and faded. GO GO SHOOT showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by TAQARUB on the turn, vied with that rival to the quarter pole, then had nothing left.
