

TENTH RACE Gulfstream Park January 16th, 2016

1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:38) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Sunshine Millions Turf S.FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD, BRED IN FLORIDA. Free nomination by Sunday, January 3. \$1,500 to enter and \$750 to start, with all starters to receive a \$750 rebate in addition to the purse. \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake at a mile or over on the turf since July 1, allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes on turf since July 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Trophy to the winningowner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth) (Rail at 84 feet). (Clear 73)

MANCHURIAN HIGH settled off the leaders from between foes, responded when set down for the drive and finished with a late surge to be going away late. REPORTING STAR stalked the pace of CEMENT CLEMENT while racing three-wide, moved up to take command nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead but could not match strides with the winner late. FUNDAMENTAL was reserved just off the leaders early, moved four-wide through the second turn, angled out further into the lane and finished with good late energy. AMIGO was forwardly placed early, moved four-wide through the second turn and finished with a steady bid. OLD TIME HOCKEY raced unhurried early, moved three-wide through the second turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished evenly late. PRINCE VINCENZO settled off the leaders early, moved five-wide through the second turn and did not menace. CEMENT CLEMENT was bumped at the break, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after going three-quarters. GOURMET DELIGHT raced off the pacesetters from between foes, moved four-wide through the second turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and did not offer a bid. BLACK MARTINO was off a step slow then allowed to settle, raced off the rail through the second turn and did not reach contention. MY POINT EXACTLY was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from between foes, moved three-wide through the second turn, checked in mid-stretch while retreating and continued to give way. RIZWAN chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going six furlongs.
