By subscription of \$300 on Friday, February 10, 2006 at \$300 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed of which \$150,000 to the Owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$25,000 to third, \$12,500 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth and \$5,000 to sixth. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over in 2006, allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over at any time allowed 5 lbs.; \$20,000 at any distance, allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races (See reverse side for additional starting limitation information). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. (Clear 57)

DENIS OF CORK relaxed nicely off the pace, came three wide when beginning a solid rally turning for home, continued in professional fashion to win going away. SIERRA SUNSET broke in, raced in the second flight off the inside, moved when asked a bit in the second turn, reached the leader under a right handed stick inside the furlong grounds, proved no match for the winner in the final strides. LIBERTY BULL unhurried early, came from between foes into the stretch, up for part of the place while not a threat to the top two late. SACRED JOURNEY sprinted out to clear into the first turn on his own courage, very quick fractions, unrateable, briefly responded when challenged upper stretch, weakened. HE'S EZE evenly paced, lacked a late kick. RILEY TUCKER settled off the pace, moved a bit closer four wide turning for home when briskly roused, lacked a further advance. ISABULL bothered at the start, never a threat. GANGBUSTER was never involved while widest in the lane. TURF WAR broke in, showed little while off the inside. ROYAL HUDSON was never close. SILVER EDITION in the second group inside, made a brief advance on the leader third quarter, stopped in the drive.
