(GRADE III) THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$500 on Friday, February 10, 2012 at \$500 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby, \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the win ner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 at a mile or over in 2012, allowed 3 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over at any time allowed 5 lb s.; \$25,000 at any distance, allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Friday, February 10, 2012 with 88 nominees. (Clear 58)

CASTAWAY away in good order, used a bit early to duel through the first turn, rated when forcing the issue in the run up the backstretch off the inside, challenged far turn, put a head in front late in the final turn, shook clear soon after and was kept to task the final furlong. JAKE MO lacked speed while racing off the inside, moved to the rail second turn, saved some ground into the stretch, split foes late and was up for the place. RECKLESS JERRY within striking distance off the inside, asked along second turn, four wide turning for home, long drive for the place, outfurnished for that position. RING IT UP forwardly placed, moved closer while three wide into the far turn, lacked a closing kick to also come up short for the place position. MAJESTIC STRIDE broke well, showed the way into the first turn, two path when showing the way into the far turn, began to weaken when headed by the winner soon after. LONGVIEW DRIVE well off the early pace, asked far turn, six wide turning for home, brushed upper stretch, finished up evenly. JUNEBUGRED raced mid pack, between foes into the second turn, asked midway on that bend, came up empty for the drive. NO SPIN devoid of speed, made little impact in picking off a couple of tiring foes. UNBRIDLED'S NOTE broke awkwardly, trailed early, in some traffic into the far turn, lacked a significant late response. LAURIE'S ROCKET six wide into the first turn, continued outside, five wide out of the second bend, tired in the drive. RED JACK forwardly placed along the inside, stopped while continuing to save ground second turn.
