FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.** By Subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$500 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. (\$25,000 from the F.T.B.O.A. Stakes Fund to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second and 11% to third for Registered Florida Breds placing First, Second or Third.) The owner of the winner to receive \$45,000, \$15,000 to second, \$8,250, \$4,500 to fourth and \$2,250 to fifth. BUFFALO MAN chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. **OUT OF GWEDDA** chased the pace along the rail, was steadied when trapped in behind **VOODOOOUTHINKUR** on the turn, angled outside the leaders for racing room in the stretch and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. **GREEN VEGAS** reserved early, angled to the out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss the place. **JAMES WILFRED** unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn, swung out widest of all for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. **STRAIGHT FACED** steadied along the inside on the backstretch, moved up to press the pace outside **VOODOOOUTHINKUR** around the turn and into the stretch, then tired. **VOODOOOUTHINKUR** showed speed along the inside into the stretch and faltered. **POP GOES THE TIGER** was done early.
