After payment of 1% to all the owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. IT'S A BIRD was caught in tight along the rail on the first turn, eased out on the backstretch, rallied three wide around the far turn to engage GOTTTCHA GOLD at the top of the stretch, then just edged that rival to the wire after a stretch long duel. GOTTTCHA GOLD vied for the lead along the rail, responded when challenged by IT'S A BIRD at the top of the stretch, then duelled with that rival and just failed in a game effort. DREAM MAESTRO reserved early, swung out for the stretch run while moving into contention, then was gaining on the top ones at the finish. MARNESIA'S BIG BOY chased the leaders three wide into the stretch and weakened. SWEETNORTHERNSAINT chased the pace duel into the stretch and tired. FINALLYMADEIT vied for the lead outside GOTTTCHA GOLD to the top of the stretch, then faltered. JUDITHS WILD RUSH sluggish away from the gate, failed to menace. WHOS CRYING NOW was not a factor. HAL'S MY HOPE was outrun.
