Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Jan), by Successful Appeal - Zophie by Hawkster. Trainer Blasi Scott. Bred by Luann Baker(FL).

APPEALING ZOPHIE sprinted clear in the early stages, raced uncontested on the lead while well clear to the turn, opened a commanding lead in upper stretch and was never threatened while being kept to the task. COTTON BLOSSOM was unhurried along the backstretch, settled in the middle of the pack to the turn, worked her way forward nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide entering the stretch and closed steadily to edge X STAR for the place. X STAR pursued the winner in the two path to the top of the stretch, raced close to that rival into deep stretch and was outfinished late by the runner-up. POST INVADER trailed to the turn, made a run along the inside leaving the turn and lacked a strong closing response. COOL THE ECONOMY chased the leaders while three wide to the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. PRO PINK lunged in the air at the start, was outrun early, rushed up inside along the backstretch, steadied along the rail nearing the far turn, gained steadily to reach contention on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. RUBY CROWN checked while breaking inward at the start, raced well back while four wide for a half, angled between horses in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. MY FAVORITE steadied sharply between horses at the half mile and gave way on the turn and was not abused in the stretch.
