WENT THE DAY WELL forwardly placed off the rail while reserved, moved up in that path into the second turn, came out three wide and moved between rivals to challenge after six furlongs, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and drew clear late. HOLIDAY PROMISE reserved for a half three wide, angled out a bit and made a good four wide middle move, challenged the leaders with a furlong to go, could not stay with the winner late but held on for the place. HEAVY BREATHING set the pace near the rail, responded when challenged before a half, went with the winner after six furlongs, battled into the final furlong and tired late. HANDSOME MIKE lost his footing a bit at the start, bumped with STEALCASE recovering, was a bit to eager into the first turn while out five wide, stayed in that path when rallying on the second turn and closed well late. STEALCASE bumped at the start, angled in soon after, raced off the inside early and lacked a closing bid. ALL SQUARED AWAY angled out four wide on the first turn when unhurried, made a bold five wide move after five furlongs but could not sustain the bid. ILL CONCEIVED pressed the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. RUSSIAN GREEK dropped back along the inside early then could not threaten. TIZANEXPENSE bumped at the start, raced six wide into the first turn when within striking distance, held on well for six furlongs and faded. RED JACK close up along the inside, faded after a half. MR. PRANKSTER four wide on the first turn, was no threat. COACH ROYAL bumped at the start, raced five wide into the first turn when close up, stayed on well for a half and stopped.
