Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Mar), by Lemon Drop Kid - Iconic Spirit by Bernstein. Trainer Chad C. Brown. Bred by Caldara Farm Inc. (KY).

SPIRIT ANIMAL broke in brushing the near side stall before bumping NOBLE SPIRIT, came under coaxing nudging STACCATO out of the way to be forwardly placed before coming under rating through the opening bend, settled two to three wide in aim of the front, had SOUTHERN BRIDGE advance outside and nudged that rival to the five path at the half mile pole when tipping out four wide, raced three wide through the far turn steadily advancing coming under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, seized command at the three-sixteenths, dug in tussling with HUBBA BUBBA latched on inside through to the sixteenth marker before shaking that rival off to inch away to the finish. HUBBA BUBBA three wide through the first turn, settled in hand attending the leader from the three path, tucked to the two path at the seven-sixteenths, came under a ride five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch between foes, dug in under a drive latched on to the aforementioned foe along the inside, fought on until shaken off in the final sixteenth, ran on willingly for the place honors. NOBLE NEBRASKAN broke out at the start coming together in a bump with AGITATOR who broke inwards, settled just off the inside in mid pack, came under coaxing tucked inside at the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, ran on to close in and secure the show honors in a good initial effort. AGITATOR broke in at the start coming together with the aforementioned foe who broke outwards, settled unhurried two to three wide near the rear of the field, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled out five wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly for the last major share. WINNING FACTOR established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand along the inside through sensible splits under attendance to the outside but little pressure, had that pressure intensify into the far turn, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths in response, spun just off the inside for home under threat, got displaced three-sixteenths out and weakened in the late stages. NOBLE SPIRIT bumped at the start by SPIRIT ANIMAL who broke inwards, tracked the pace along the inside, came under a ride three furlongs from home, angled out four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late going. JUSTCALLMENORMAN three wide through the first turn, settled three wide in pursuit from near the rear, came under coaxing at the three-eighths advancing in a mild bid into striking range five-sixteenths from home, swung five wide into upper stretch, couldn't sustain the momentum and weakened. ANGELO'S CORNER saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, got urged along three furlongs from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. SOUTHERN BRIDGE three wide through the first turn, raced three to four wide just off the pace, advanced outside from the four path nearing the half mile pole and was nudged five wide briefly by SPIRIT ANIMAL, tucked to the two path at the seven-sixteenths, came under coaxing three furlongs out, swung four wide for home and weakened in the stretch. STACCATO hit the off side stall at the start getting away two lengths slow, got bumped soon after by SPIRIT ANIMAL and bobbled after the start, settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the nine-sixteenths, lost contact with the field through the far turn, went just off the inside into upper stretch and was eased through to the finish.
