1 MILE. (1:35²) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 (Includes \$40,000 OBP - Oklahoma Bred Program. Pluses \$40,000 OBP - Oklahoma Bred Program.) Remington Springboard Mile S.FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$2,500 to pass the entry box. Starters to pay \$3,500 additional with \$400,000 guaranteed. The guaranteed monies to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Colts and Geldings, 121 lbs.; Fillies, 118 lbs. First preference to stakes winning or stake-placed horses in graded/group stakes (in order I,II,III), then preference to lifetime earnings. Lifetime earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. The top three finishers in the Springboard Mile will get an automatic nomination to the Oklahoma Derby in 2018. The winner will receive an all fees paid entry into the Oklahoma Derby in 2018. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Thursday, December 7th with (59) nominations. (Cloudy 47)

GREYVITOS stalked the pace while three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn and drew clear in upper stretch then was kept to a drive in the end. COMBATANT was settled on the inside on the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn, was gaining ground and finished well in the end. KINGSVILLE was unhurried early then rallied two wide on the far turn, was gaining ground willingly in late stretch. NIGHT STRIKE was in tight soon after the start and propped entering the first turn, dropped back while in hand by the rider, started a rally on the far turn and swung out to be five wide and closed willingly in the end. MAJOR BROWN set the early pace while being pressured from the inside, was in a long drive then gave way in the stretch drive. BELIEVE IN ROYALTY was allowed to settled then rallied four wide on the backstretch into the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the drive. BODE'S MAKER was allowed to settled then raced two wide on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn and was no menace in the stretch. FLIP THE COIN JAN was in tight and bumped then steadied off rivals heels into the first turn, raced five wide into the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. BRANGELINA was allowed to settled then raced three wide on the far turn then failed to menace. REDATORY stalked the pace while two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then gave way in the stretch drive. SOUL P SAY was in tight and bumped on the first turn, raced three wide on the backstretch, was used up and stopped. FLAT LUCKY was bumped on the first turn then settled while inside into the far turn and stopped.
