SILVERFOOT settled inside, moved up along the rail, angled out, took the lead upper stretch, drew off late while urged. TELLING was unhurried early, edged to the leaders in the second turn, but couldn't go by the winner and held place. CANELA raced in the second flight, drew even between horses in the second turn, was no match for the winner but saved a share. CLOUDY'S KNIGHT was taken back early, angled out six wide in the stretch and had a mild rally. BOROBUDUR had no speed, steadied in the second turn, altered course eight wide and was gaining. MAJOR RHYTHM was void of early speed, made a brief bid, steadied in the stretch but had no late kick. RUMOR HAS IT set all of the pace, opened up a huge lead early, was used up and dropped back. A. P. XCELLENT was unhurried early and failed to menace. LATTICE saved ground, had no rally and was far back in the stretch. RACE RUN IN LANE 1.
