TRIFECTA 10-2-7 PAID \$255.00 Bay Gelding, (Mar), by English Channel - I Can Fan Fan by Lear Fan. Trainer Brueggemann A. Roger. Bred by Midwest THE PIZZA MAN moved willingly to a forward position tracking the long lead of the pacesetting BIG KICK while clear of the others, advanced on that foe leaving the backstretch for the second time, took over three and a half furlongs out, faced pressure from an outside rival in EYE OF THE STORM, fended off that foe leaving the third turn, drew clear in upper stretch, received steady handling to the wire and lasted. DANDINO (GB) settled at the fore of the second group to track the leading quartet racing just off the rail, advanced off the inside two to three wide into the lane, was gaining on the winner with good energy but was too late and settled for the place. HAVANA BEAT (IRE) settled last but one through the early going racing off the inside, began to advance up the backstretch the second time in the four or five path, continued three wide on the third turn and gained slowly through the lane. MOMENT IN TIME (IRE) was held up at the rear early, advanced along the inside on the third turn, steadied on heels midway on that bend and was forced to wait a bit behind horses while beginning to shift out leaving that bend, had angled four wide at the top of the lane and belatedly gained ground but was too late. EYE OF THE STORM (IRE) bobbled at the break then was urged to a forward position, stalked the leader racing outside a rival early, continued in the two path while edging closer heading into the third turn, was ridden three furlongs out, reached contention midway on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. ADMIRAL KITTEN raced between rivals in the middle of the trailing group for the opening mile, dropped back to last on the third turn, shifted five wide into the lane and improved position. MORO TAP settled inside a trio racing toward the rear, continued to save ground to the third turn, shifted to the three path for that bend, was four wide into the lane and lacked the needed bid. INFINITE MAGIC established good position tracking the leading group inside, weakened after eleven furlongs. SUNTRACER raced three wide throughout, made no bid. BIG KICK moved readily to the front to set the pace, extended the advantage on the second turn and into the run up the backstretch, was headed three furlongs out, faltered, and faded.
