After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remainingpurse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed, 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden, claiming or starter, 4 lbs. The field will be limited tofourteen starters. MO TOM was unhurried early, fanned into the seven path in the turn, rallied into the lane, took over command in the stretch, drew clear and held sway in the final stages. TOM'S READY chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn, angled to the rail late in the stretch and was gaining on the winner in the final stages. UNCLE BRENNIE stalked the pace early, made a bid four wide entering the lane but weakened late in the stretch run. DISCREETNESS was on the inside early, shifted into the three path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. COTTON TOWN was bumped at the start, fanned into the eight path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but faded late. MY MAJESTIC FLIGHT improved position. JUNKERS dueled early three wide, fanned into the five path in the turn and was empty late. PINNACLE PEAK pressed the pace early from between horses, shifted into the three path in the turn and was tired late. SHOGOOD was through after three quarters.
